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2023 TRIBAL MEMBERSHIP CREDENTIAL PROCESS

UINO membership is made up of Tribes, Individuals, and Organizations who have met the eligibility criteria and the payment of dues as outlined in Article III of the UINO by-laws. Annual membership dues shall be due and payable on or before the Annual Convention each year. All members are determined to be in good standing upon full payment of tribal dues.

Articles from the United Indian Nations of Oklahoma Constitution and By-laws applicable to the membership process (all sections found in Article III - Membership):

Section 1:

The membership of the United Indian Nations in Oklahoma, Kansas, and Texas shall be of the following three categories:

1. **Tribal Membership:** Only federally recognized Tribal Nations based in the state of Oklahoma shall be eligible for Tribal membership in this organization. Any eligible Tribal Nation must submit a Tribal resolution from its governing body officially stating its willingness to be a Tribal member of UINO - any member of Tribal Nation may withdraw from UINO at any time by submitting a Tribal resolution stating a willingness to withdraw from UINO. A Tribal Nation based in Oklahoma that has submitted a resolution stating its willingness to join the United Indian Nations of Oklahoma, Kansas and Texas is not required to submit an additional resolution to be a Tribal member of UINO.
2. **Individual Membership:** Any person of legal voting age who is a citizen of a Tribal Nation based in Oklahoma is eligible for individual membership.
3. **Organization Membership:** Tribal, corporate, and nonprofit organizations are eligible for organizational membership.

Section 2:

Tribal Nation Delegates and Alternates: A member of Tribal Nation shall vote through either a delegate or alternate chosen by the Tribal Nation. A delegate or alternate must be elected or appointed official of the member of Tribal Nation to vote on behalf of the Tribal Nation. A delegate or alternate that no longer serves the Tribal Nation as an elected or appointed official may not vote on behalf of the member Tribal Nation. Upon the selection of a delegate and alternate, each Tribal Nation shall provide the name, title, and address for each delegate and alternate to the Secretary of UINO.

Section 3:

Dues: The annual membership dues shall be in three classes:

1. **Tribal Membership:** The following scale shall be the basis of dues assessment for each Tribal Nation. Total Tribal Membership of 0-500 members: **\$400**; 501-1000 members: **\$800**; 1001-2000 members: **\$1000**; 2001-3000 members: **\$3000**; 3001 and above : **\$4000**. A member Tribal Nation must pay annual on or before Annual Convention to be eligible to vote. The Executive Committee, consisting of the officers of UINO, has discretion to reduce, raise, or waive Tribal Nations dues.
2. **Individual Membership:** Individual Membership dues shall be \$50 per individual and are due on or before the time of registration at each annual convention to be eligible to vote. Individuals who are elders (60 years of age and over) and college students shall pay reduced membership fees of \$25 per person.
3. **Organization/Business Membership:** Organization Membership dues shall be \$1000 per organization and are due on or before registration at each annual convention. Organization member shall be eligible to vote.
